



WALLINGFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS 4-Year old Pre-K Programs

NOW is the time to call to set up a screening appointment if you have a child turning four years old by January 1, 2019 and are a Wallingford resident.

Wallingford Public Schools has three Pre-K programs:

- A Smart Start Pre-K program which is full day and accepts 64 students. This program is located at Moses Y. Beach Elementary School and at Highland Elementary School.
- A half day Pre-K program which is held either in the morning or the afternoon and accepts 64 students. This program is located at Cook Hill Elementary School and at E.C. Stevens Elementary School.
- An Integrated Preschool program which is either half day afternoon OR full day depending on program need. This program has approximately 50% typically developing children who serve as peer models for the students who have been identified as requiring special education. This program is located at Cook Hill Elementary School.

There is no cost to families accepted into the program, however, the district does **NOT** provide transportation. Pre-K program placement may not align with your neighborhood school district.

If your child is accepted into the Pre-K program, a copy of the child's birth certificate and a physical examination, including a record of immunizations, will be required. Families will be notified of acceptance in writing by the first week of June 2018.
