MBHS SUMMER READING PROGRAM: 2019-2020

THIS INFORMATION MAY BE PRINTED FROM THE MOUNTAIN BROOK HIGH SCHOOL WEBSITE: The summer reading program is intended to introduce students to a variety of reading materials. These works should **both supplement and enhance the literary works covered within the school year** curriculum as well as help foster a love of reading. **Students should not choose books they have read previously.**

1. Those students who will be in **College Prep English** (formerly labeled "Regular")courses are required to read the following books designated by grade level:

10th GRADE: (2 books) two required, one fiction and one non-fiction

11th GRADE: (3 books) two required novels and selections from an anthology of

essays (only sections VIII and X from the anthology are required)

12th GRADE: (2 books) two required, one fiction and one non-fiction.

- 2. Advanced or AP classes have separate lists and special instructions.
- 3. **Dual Enrollment 12** has a separate list.
- 3. All books should be read by **the FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL in August**. Students should be prepared for class discussion, written analysis, and/or other evaluation the first few days of school.
