

## Return to Learning Update

- We have made contact with 85% of our students.
  - 50.2% will not be returning to in-person learning.
  - 34.8% will be returning in-person learning.
  - Chromebook/laptop distribution will begin with students enrolling in the Virtual Academy.
- We still have a team working on making contact with the remaining 15% of our students.
- Currrently, we have 3,701 students have registered for the Virtual Academy.

### Schedules and Meals

#### **Key Points**

- Breakfast will be served in the cafeteria with appropriate spacing.
- Students will walk from the cafeteria and eat breakfast in the classroom or other location where practical.
- Students who opted for distance learning will have a specific protocol for breakfast and lunch.
- Lunch will be provided to students prior to dismissal to take home.
- Elementary restroom breaks are staggered with time in-between to clean.
- Middle School and High School schedules have been altered to reduce transitions.
- Increased time for staff to professionally develop.
- Increased time for staff to work with families and students.
- Collaborating with YMCA, other approved partners and leveraging the 21st century grant to provide opportunities for student enrichment to extend the day up to 6:00pm.

# Waterbury Public Schools COVID-19 Notification Protocol


The COVID-19 Notification Protocol is under development. The final version will be completed next week after discussions with the Health Department.
