***Driver's Ed will be met only on the first day of each session from 9:30-12:30 with eDays for the remainder of the session and an additional 3-hour drive time to be scheduled on the first day.**

How do I register?

Registration forms will be available online and in the counseling office starting Friday, February 26, 2021. Forms and payment may be mailed to Mountain Brook High School, Attn: Summer School, 3650 Bethune Drive, Mountain Brook, AL 35223. You may also bring your form and check to the counseling office during regular school hours. Forms will be accepted beginning Tuesday, March 2, 2021. Registration forms for Driver's Ed that are mailed in will be taken after walk-ins are accepted each day.

What does it cost?

The cost for each course is \$200.00 per session before April 30, 2021 (\$220.00 per session starting May 1, 2021). Final decisions on classes offered depend upon the number of students enrolled. If classes do not make, checks will be returned by the first day of the session. The deadline to apply is **May 14, 2021**.

There is a \$25.00 processing fee for all classes dropped before June 1, 2020. **NO REFUNDS ARE GIVEN ONCE THE SESSION BEGINS!**

When will I receive confirmation regarding summer school enrollment?

Emails will be sent out weekly as rosters are updated confirming placement in the class for which you are registered.

Attendance & Discipline Code:

- More than one (1) absence in a session will result in a loss of credit. Four (4) tardies will be considered as one (1) absence.
- Students MUST attend the first day of a summer school session.
- All rules and regulations listed in the student handbook apply to summer school.
- The grading scale for summer school is the same scale for MBHS.
