The Alaska Native Sisterhood Camp #19 has established a scholarship fund to provide three \$1,000 scholarships and one \$300 Karen Patotzka Memorial Scholarship to Craig High School graduating seniors who plan on continuing their education at a post-secondary educational institution or a vocational school during the fall term after graduation.

Application Procedure:

Submit a completed application to Ms. Riedel at CHS no later than May 9th, 2022 at 3:45pm to be considered.

The following items must be submitted:

- A. Completed application
- B. Responses to 4 essay questions
- C. High School Transcripts

Selection Criteria:

Applications will be judged according to the following criteria:

Scholarship recipients will be notified at the Craig High School scholarship ceremony. A check will be mailed directly to the student's educational institution after a copy of the student's transcript or grade report from the first semester, providing the student maintains a 2.0 GPA for a full-time course load, or shows acceptable performance and full-time attendance at a vocational school. In addition, the student is required to provide evidence of enrollment for the second quarter/semester. Submit verifications to the mailing address listed above.
