



## Historically Black Colleges & Universities (HBCUs)

- Common Black College
   Application (CBCA)
  - \$20 Application Fee to Apply to all 56 Member Institutions



HBCUs are a source of accomplishment and great pride for the African American community as well as the entire nation. The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, defines an HBCU as: "...any historically black college or university that was established prior to 1964, whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans, and that is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association determined by the Secretary [of Education] to be a reliable authority as to the quality of training offered or is, according to such an agency or association, making reasonable progress toward accreditation." - <a href="https://sites.ed.gov/whhbcu/one-hundred-and-five-historically-black-colleges-and-universities/">https://sites.ed.gov/whhbcu/one-hundred-and-five-historically-black-colleges-and-universities/</a>

  - 1. Submit <u>FAFSA</u> or <u>California Dream Act</u> <u>Application</u>
  - 2. Mesa will electronically send your Cal Grant GPA to the CSAC
  - 3. After submitting your FAFSA or CADAA Create an Account at <u>WebGrants4Students</u> to check the status of your Cal Grant

#### **Types of Cal Grants**

#### Cal Grants

#### Cal Grant A

For students with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least **3.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

#### Cal Grant B

For students from disadvantaged or low income families with a GPA of at least **2.0**, family income and assets below the state ceilings, and who demonstrate financial need

#### Cal Grant C

For students from low income families pursuing occupational, technical, and vocational programs of study
