# **Assignments: Choose ONE**

- 1. <u>Alternate Book Cover:</u> Using your book cover as a model, choose another significant element from the book to illustrate and design another cover. Be sure to include all important identifying information for your cover to be complete.
- 2. Reader-Response Journal: Provide a journal entry for all of the following.
- If you were making a movie of this book, who would you cast and why? Support your choices with textual evidence.
- Share a favorite quote from the book. Why did this quote stand out? Support your claim.
- If you had the chance to ask the author one question about the book, what would it be and why?
- Which character from the book would you most like to meet and why?
- 3. <u>"Fakebook" Page:</u> Create a "fake-book" page for the main character. The Handout/Template will be available on the school website in the student section. Hard copies can also be picked up from your English teacher before the end of the school year.
- 4. <u>Character Playlist:</u> Create a playlist for the main character. Choose ten songs you think the main character would listen to and provide textual evidence for why you chose each song.
