

2023 - 2024 ADMISSION GUIDELINES



Student Selection Criteria

Students who will be entering grades 10, 11 or 12 in the next school year are eligible for admittance to the Montgomery Preparatory Academy for Career Technologies based upon the following criteria:

- 1. A completed **electronic** application
- 2. Attendance Profile
- 3. Career Interest Inventory Assessment (Kuder)
- 4. Student must have a GPA of 2.0 to apply for the Automotive and other Dual Enrollment programs
- 5. Earned 4 core credits from the previous grade
- 6. No more than 1 credit deficiency toward graduation
- 7. Students will be interviewed at their zone school during the week of April 10th 21st. Please ensure that the phone number listed on the **electronic** application is accurate.

Admissions Process

The admissions process involves a review of student records and application. Application to MPACT requires the following steps:

- 1. Complete an **electronic** application *Click here for online application*
- 2. Kuder Assessment Report (obtained by MPACT)
- 3. Most recent Report Card (obtained by MPACT)
- 4. All electronic applications are due by Friday, March 17, 2023 @ 3:30 p.m.

Selection Process

All eligible applicants will be interviewed by MPACT instructors during the week of April 10th – 21st at their zone school. (See Guidance for school interview dates)

Program Acceptance

Letters will be hand delivered by MPACT Leadership to spring applications notifying them of their status on Wednesday, May 10, 2023 between 8:30 – 2:00. Parents will need to scan the QR Code at the bottom of the letter. Once the QR is scanned, parents/students will be able to complete the acceptance form using a provided code. All acceptance forms must be completed by May 26 at 3:00 p.m. Students who do not receive acceptance letters may reapply for the next year (2024-2025).

Criteria To Remain in Program

- 1. Maintain a GPA of 2.0 in your major (MPACT) and a 2.0 in Dual Enrollment (Trenholm State)
- 2. Maintain satisfactory attendance and behavior
- 3. Meet all financial obligations to MPACT- including the Career Tech Student Organization
- 4. Participate in all required program activities
- 5. Participate in (1) 1-hour community service projects monthly (JAG Students)
