Analysis-in 2020-2021 there was a 4% increase in students proficient on CAASPP.

Goal is 5%. Students SRI increased from 48% to 69% who were proficient or advanced.

54% of students are not meeting grade level standards.

Added Reflex Math for 1st-5th grades
