Standard	What does this standard mean for my child?
2.RL.3.2	Character point of view in a fictional story
2.RN.3.1	Text Features in a nonfiction story
2.RF.4.3	Use knowledge of short and long vowel sounds when reading one syllable words *Will also be taught in grading periods 2, 3, and 4*
2.RF.4.4	High frequency words and abbreviations *Will also be taught in grading periods 2, 3, and 4*
2.RF.4.6	Read multisyllabic words with roots, suffixes, and prefixes *Will also be taught in grading periods 2, 3, and 4*
2.RV.2.1	Use context clues/text features to determine meaning of unknown words
2.RV.2.2	Understand synonyms, antonyms, multiple meaning words *Will also be taught in grading periods 2, 3, and 4*
2.W.2.1	Forms letters correctly with appropriate spacing *Will also be taught in grading periods 2, 3, and 4*

2.W.6.2c	Spell short/ long vowels, and r-controlled blends, and second grade high frequency words *Will also be taught in grading periods 2, 3, and 4*
