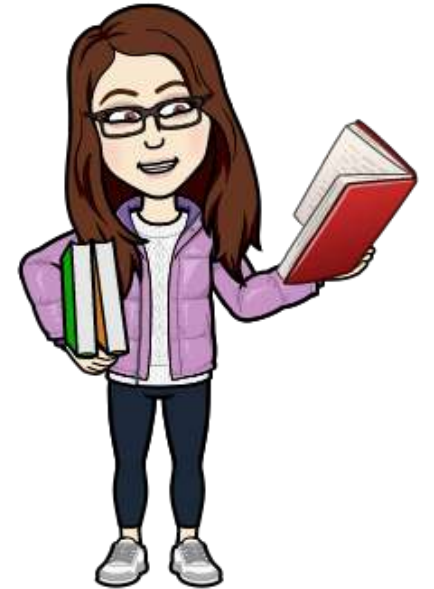

i-Ready Reading and Math Program

- ▶ i-Ready is used throughout CNUSD
- ▶ Online tool to reinforce Reading and Math skills taught in the classroom
- ▶ Students take a Diagnostic Test 3 times a year.
- ▶ Program is tailored to each student's needs and adjusts based on how they pass or don't pass the lessons/quizzes.
- ▶ i-Ready will be part of our daily school work this year. Students should complete 20-30 minutes daily of either reading or math.
- ▶ Please DO NOT help them on the program as it adjusts to each individual child's needs.

<p>Help your child wake up and eat before class.</p> 	<p>Be close by in case your child needs assistance or technical help is needed.</p>	<p>Set up regular break times for eating and movement.</p> 
<p>Make sure your child has school materials ready when zoom starts.</p> 	<p>Remember the camera and microphone are on and sometimes muted during our meeting. Monitor your home for excessive noise and inappropriate clothes.</p>	<p>Help your child complete the work assigned and turn it in. Please <u>do not</u> do the work yourself! Assist by helping to read instructions and guiding them in the correct direction. ** it is okay if they don't have the correct answer all the time.</p>
<p>You will need to help your child log in to class for the first several meetings.</p> 	<p> Plug in the computer each night!</p> 	<p>I am here to help. Please email me or send me a Remind message and I will respond as soon as I can. My office hours 12-1 will have the fastest response time.</p>

Grading Scale

- ▶ 95%-100%= O Student's work is "Outstanding", Above and Beyond what is required.
- ▶ 90%-94% = O- Outstanding, "Great Job"
- ▶ 80%-89% = S+ Above average work, "Good job"
- ▶ 70%-79% = S Average work. This is what is expected from most of the students in the classroom.
- ▶ 65%-69% = S- The subject has not been mastered. This grade would be below the state standard for a 2nd grade student.
- ▶ 0%-64% = N This grade is given when a student has not grasped a concept, whatsoever. It may also represent "no effort". The student would be below grade level in the subject.
- ▶ *Progress Reports will be sent home for N grades or students in danger of receiving an N.



High Frequency Word Lists/Sight Words

- ▶ These will be coming home in the next few weeks. I will either email or post in Google classroom.
- ▶ There are 10 lists. These are District adopted lists.
- ▶ I appreciate all your help with having your child practice these at home daily as it is essential to reading development.



Classroom/Remote Learning Supplies

- ▶ I have included some of the supplies you child will need in the First Pick-up bag that you will pick-up at Highland on Tuesday, August 11th from 9:30-10:30. There will also be a make-up day announced soon.
- ▶ Your child will also need some blank white copy paper to write on during our zoom meetings. Lined paper will work also.
- ▶ There will be some things you need to print out also from our Google Classroom Assignments. If you don't have a working printer, students can write their answers on a seperate sheet of paper most of the time.
- ▶ There will be multiple pickup days throughout our remote learning time.
