NEW: Little League Baseball has decided to adopt the new bat standard for mandated use effective January 1, 2018. All Jewett City Little League baseball players must comply with the new bat standard.

Q: Early Care?? YES! NEW 7:10 til 9:00 am!

**A: Yes, drop off at 7:10 am is \$50 per week fee, for the
WHOLE family!**

Q: What does my child bring each day?

**A: Glad you asked! 1 lunch, atleast 2 snacks
& (optional) ice cream truck money.**

Q: Can I pay week to week?

**A: Yes! Just need to pay for first week, you wish to attend, in
advance then pay at-least 7-days in advance for other weeks.
More than two weeks late, you child will be removed from
program.**

*(To get the Super Saver Discount, you must pay for each
week between Now til April 8th, online.*

*Sorry, you cannot reserve spots with the discount without
payment)*

Q: Do I have to go to each week?

A: No, just pick and choose which weeks you want.

Q: Do you offer financial assistance?

**A: Yes, TVCCA is offering slide scale spots but they are limit-
ed. Must register before June 1st.**

Q: What happened to the field trips?

**A: This year, we will not have any. We are budgeting more
camp entertainment rather than traveling during the
pandemic and during summer months.**

Q: Am I able to switch weeks?

A: Yes, just let us know at-least 7 days in advance.

Q: Can I pay online?

**A: Yes, www.griswoldrec.org, click on Summer Camp link.
Then "Sign Me Up!" Then create an account, register & pay.
Or if you attend last year, just click "Sign In" on the account
screen. (update email and cell phone please)**

Q: Can I pay cash or check at camp, the first day?

**A: No, Board of Finance Policy states you must mail in
checks or money orders (no cash) or drop either off at the
Finance Office, second floor of the Town Hall. So, please pay
for at-least first week ahead of time. If payment is not
recieved, the child will not be able to attend until it is
recieved.**

Q: How much does a week of camp cost?

**A: \$110 = Griswold/Jewett City Resident
\$130 = Non-Resident**

Q: Do you offer part-time rates?

**(Which means, attending only one day a week.)
A. Yes, the cost of one-day a week is \$50 per day.**

Q: Can I sign up on the first day?

**A. Yes, BUT you would have to register in person at the
camp, THEN go drop off any checks, cash to the Finance
Office at the Town Hall. (It's easier to pay in advance...)**

Q: Can I mail in my application and payment?

**A. No, sorry. Everything is done online or just come in to the
Youth Center to get assistance in person.**

PLEASE REMEMBER

Always have a change of clothes just in case!

Always bring a reusable water bottle with child's name on it.

Please wear sneakers, no crocks or sandels.

**Pick Up by 5 pm, if late past 5:15 pm then a charge of \$35
late pick up fee will be applied each time.**
