








DISNEY SPIRIT DAY FRIDAY, MARCH 24

- Harriet Tubman a spy who led slaves to freedom during the Civil War.
- Amelia Earhart world's first female pilot.
- Madeleine Albright first female Secretary of State in 1996.
- Misty Copeland first African-American woman to be named Principal
 Dancer highest level in the 75-year history of American Ballet Theatre
 in 2015.


