There were no Board comments.


Approval of Agenda and Proposed Agenda Modifications

Tonight we are going to focus on moving forward and there is still work to be done in our middle schools. These are just ideas and this will be your last time to give public input because what will happen next is we will work with this Board and this Committee behind the scenes and bring a recommendation to the Board sometime in May. We changed the wording from Neighborhood Middle Schools to Middle School Curriculum and it is the same thing you saw before. We have taken off the demographics. I am proposing tonight the idea that everybody that attends a magnet in two years will take nothing but honors courses, there will be no regular courses. If they are magnet students they will be taking honors courses. If they do not qualify for the honors they do not qualify for the magnets.

- Students not attending Dothan City Schools must apply for the magnet school in order to be considered for enrollment.
- Attendance requirement to enter/remain at magnet school.
- Eliminate "requirement" for parent participation/involvement.
- Go back to numerical grading. For example: 92/A or 76/C. Not just a letter grade.
