Carver students in fourth, fifth, and sixth grades will take the MAP® Growth™ tests from NWEA® two times each year. Scores from these tests help teachers check student performance by measuring achievement and growth. Teachers use results to tailor classroom lessons and set goals for students.

The MAP tests are taken on the computer and adapt to your child's responses to measure your child's skill level. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. These results will provide a more complete picture of what your child knows and is ready to learn—whether it is on, above, or below their grade level.

Since MAP Growth tests provide immediate and accurate information about your child's learning, it's easy for teachers to identify students with similar scores that are generally ready for instruction in similar skills and topics, and then plan instruction accordingly.
