By the end of the first semester, every child should be able to:

English Language Arts	Math
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read a 4th grade level benchmark passage fluently • Write at least a 3 paragraph paper including: topic sentence, details, supporting sentences, summary/conclusion. • Write a paragraph with a topic sentence, details and summary statement. • Write a complete sentence using appropriate: tone, verb, usage, capitalization, spelling, and punctuation. • Distinguish the main idea and details. • Draw inferences and make conclusions about text showing proof. • Write a topic sentence. • Use vocabulary strategies to determine the meaning of an unfamiliar word. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know multiplication facts through the 12's • Know place value through the millions and write numbers in standard, word and expanded notation. • Solve multi-digit multiplication. • Divide a multi-digit number by a 1 digit number by a one digit divisor • Multiply a 2 digit number by a 2 digit number. • Place a simplified fractions on a number line. • Convert decimals to fractions and fractions to decimals. • Simplify fractions.

As we progress through the semester and it becomes evident that a child may not master or already has mastered these objectives we will provide strategic interventions through:

1. Open Court Workshop (30 minutes within the home room class)
2. Teaming and Re-Grouping (30 minutes with possibly another teacher that is providing (intensive, strategic, benchmark or challenge intervention)
3. After School Intervention
