#### Arrival and Dismissal Time:

  ☐ Talking about feeling hopeless or having no purpose
- Talking about feeling trapped or being in unbearable pair
- ☐ Talking about being a burden to others
  ☐ increasing the use of alcohol or drugs
- ☐ Acting anklous, agitated, or reckless ☐ Bleeping too little or too much
- Withdrawing or feeling icolated
- ☐ Showing rage or talking about seeking reven
