

Everyday, students are expected to log in to their Google Classroom page and work on assignments.

There will be a **daily** morning activity to complete and turn in.

Throughout the year, I will add other assignments into the Google Classroom Classwork page.

Homework

- Nightly homework will be assigned and written in the students' Agenda Planners.
- Reading Homework: Students are expected to 1) read a book of their choice for 20 minutes and 2) choose a question from their response journal to answer. Students must choose different questions each day.
- Math Homework: Students are expected to complete selected questions/problems from their math workbook.
- Special projects may be included throughout the year.
- According to the district board policy, students in grades 4-6, should have homework for 30-60 minutes, up to 4 days a week.
- Students in ELP (Expanded Learning Program) are not required to complete and turn in homework as they have an hour long reading block in ELP.
