Jayson Frishcknecht said, “I miss the little kids’ playground. It is because I am a little kid.”



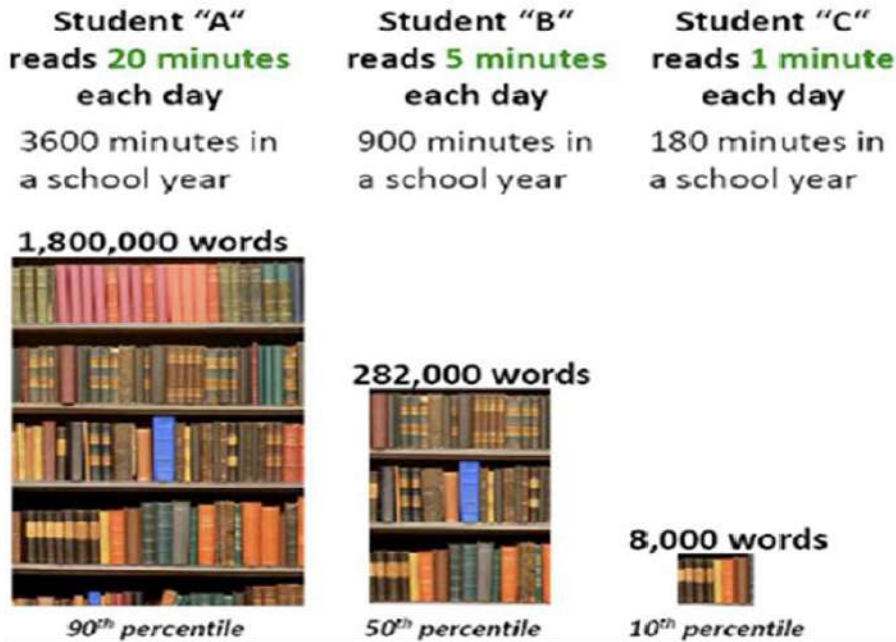
