Use to ask for an amount or explanation.

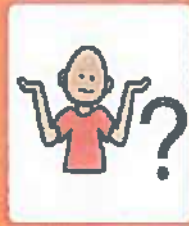
If someone asks a question that starts with the word **HOW**, your answer is an amount or explanation.
