By the end of the first semester, every child should be able to:

<p>English Language Arts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 	<p>Math</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Determine the prime factors of all numbers through 50. • Determine whether numbers are prime or composite and write the numbers as a product of their prime factors using exponents to show multiples of a factor. • Demonstrate proficiency with division, including division with positive decimals and multi digit advisors. • Analyze problems by identifying relationships, distinguishing relevant from irrelevant information, sequencing and prioritizing information. • Know their multiplication facts through 12's. • Model and identify a fraction on a number line and by drawing models with shaded parts of a whole. • Simplify and write an equivalent fraction. • Add and subtract a given fraction. • Convert an improper fraction to a mixed number.
