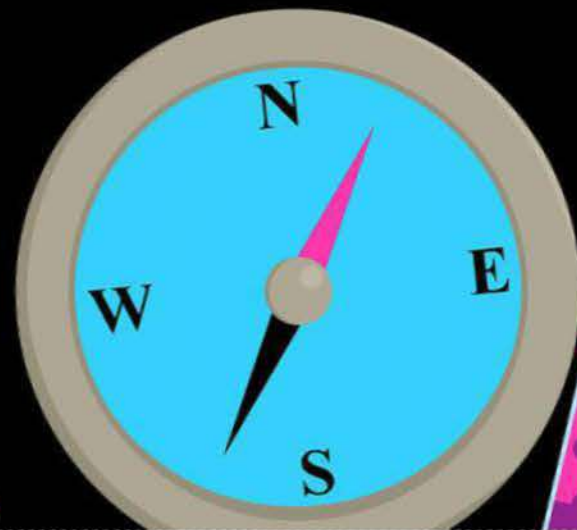
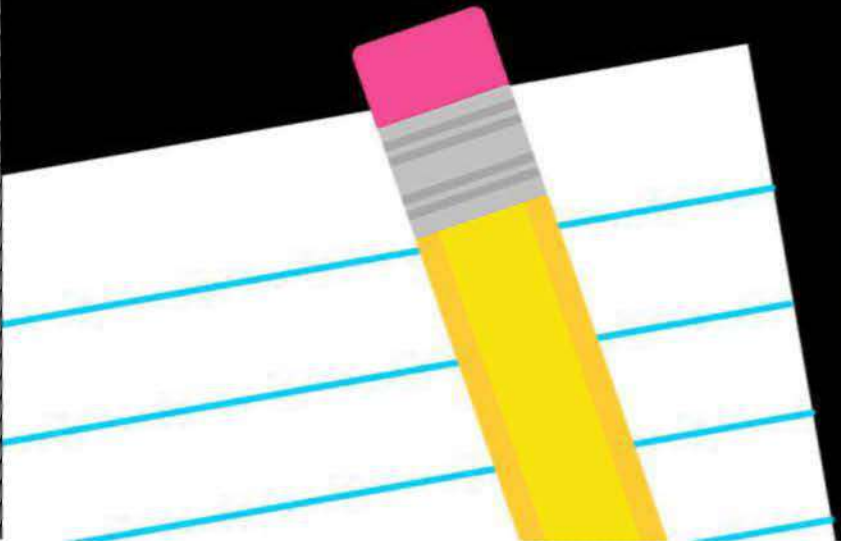

Expectations

Students:

Classroom Procedures

Classroom Management System

- Character Counts!
- Classroom Rules
- **Rewards** – verbal praise, Curran Cash, Magic Mustang coupons, table points, line points, class rewards, specials, etc.
 - **Consequences** – verbal reminders, time out in class, time out in another class, loss of rewards and/or privileges, parent meeting, office, etc.
 - **Referral/Behavior Strike** – Quarterly Fun Days



Classroom Procedures

GRADING POLICY

Tests, Progress Reports, and Report Cards

- No letter grades
- Standards scores only – report learning (Scale 1-4)
3=meeting 5th grade standards, 4=exceeding 5th grade standards

Homework

- Graded for completeness (Check plus, check, Check minus)
- Some optional homework
- Checking for mastery of subjects



Friday Folders

- Every Friday
- This is done to eliminate “surprises” when it comes to progress report and report card time.
- Please sign the cover sheet, place it back in the cover of the folder, and return it to school by Tuesday of the following week.

If your child is having a hard time adjusting to writing down their homework on a daily basis or bringing home the correct materials, please let me know so we can work together to help your child.
