Murrieta Valley Unified School District News

All schools in the district will get new solar energy systems next summer that could provide 15 to 20 percent of their electricity and cut energy costs. The project will cost \$10.5 million and will be paid for out of the district's facility budget. The funds cannot be used for school operational costs such as teacher salaries, school supplies or instructional materials.

By adding the solar systems, the district will receive rebates from the California Solar Initiative, which are expected to be \$500,000 per year for five years. In addition, the district will be eligible for lower electricity rates. The savings from the reduction in energy usage, lower rates and rebates will go to the district's general fund. The solar project is expected to save the district a minimum of about \$18 million 25 years.
