Writing Topics/Mini QuickWrites

Below are three writing topics for this week. Write 1+ paragraphs about the topic, being sure to include all required information (answer the questions). Remember you must have at least 5+ sentences! <u>QW1</u>

Write a movie or tv review for something you have watched while away from school. Be sure to include the name of the show or movie, how you saw it (NetFlix, DVD, Disney+, etc.), what it's about, who stars in it, and your opinion of it and why.

QW2

Write about what you and your family have been up to since you have been away from school. Tell me what fun activities you have done as a group. What have you done not related to school (cleaned the garage, painted your room, played video games, etc.).

<u>QW3</u>

What are some things you like about being able to stay home and not have to attend school? What are some things you dislike about having to stay home and not attend school?

PART 3: State Report

8. Major Attractions

In 2 or more paragraphs, name 2 or 3 places that you would like to visit. Name the place or attraction. Tell where it is located in your state, and why you would want to visit there.

9. Major Cities

Choose 3 major cities from your state. Write a paragraph about each of these cities. Why did you choose these cities? What is the population of each city, etc.

10. Evaluation

In 2 or more paragraphs, tell how you feel you did on this report. How much do you feel you learned? What would you change or keep the same?

11. Bibliography

List all books, magazines, or other forms of information you used to do this report. Include the title, author, publication date, and pages used.

12. Table of Contents - Create and attach to Part 3, but DO NOT turn in a binder or Parts 1 & 2

Number all your pages and create a table of contents page. *This needs to be placed in the front of your binder*. The order does not have to be the same as it appears in this outline. *Organize your paper in a way that makes sense to you and be sure to number your pages*.

13. State Flag

On a piece of paper, draw and color your state flag. The state flag *must* be drawn, fill the entire page, and cannot be traced or reproduced.

14. <u>Other</u>

Use the other information from your rough draft/notes to include other important facts about your state or the people in it.
