Instruction

Home Schooling/Equivalent Education Under Parental Direction

The Griswold Board of Education believes that formal education in the public schools is highly beneficial both for the child and for the society, but it also recognizes the right of parents to fulfill their obligation to ensure an education of their children by schooling them at home. The Board instructs the school administration to work cooperatively with home schooling parents.

It is understood that the Griswold Public Schools has no obligation under the law to provide services to children who are being home schooled. Therefore, home schooled students are not eligible for school offerings or activities. No special education or related services shall be provided to a child who is home schooled. Home schooled students are ineligible to receive a Griswold High School diploma nor graduate from Griswold High School.

Parents who wish to educate their child at home must file with the Superintendent of Schools a "Notice of Intent, Instruction of Students at Home" form within ten (10) days of the start of the home instruction program. A Notice of Intent will only be effective for the school year in which it is filed.
