Welcome to the 2021/2022 school year. We are very excited to share all the information regarding one of the sixth-grade science camp highlights. Currently, we plan to attend Thousand Pines Outdoor Science Camp during the week of November 16-19, depending on whether the school district will allow overnight trips due to the pandemic.

Thousand Pines has an online registration site powered by Campdoc.com. The  $6^{th}$  grade team will provide you with the link within the first few weeks of school so you can process your child's online registration. We scheduled a  $6^{th}$  grade parent meeting in the MPR on Wednesday, August 18 from 6:00-7:00 p.m.

We encourage all sixth graders to attend camp, as it is not only an enjoyable way to get to know one's classmates in a camp atmosphere but also a great way to experience science in an outdoor setting. The curriculum taught at Thousand Pines meets the  $6^{th}$  grade Common Core Standards for science.

We also strongly encourage all sixth graders to purchase a sixth-grade t-shirt for \$15 regardless of whether they attend camp or not. The sixth-grade t-shirt is worn during certain school events, on spirit days (Friday), and during any field trips taken this year.
