## **Incoming 6th Grade Information Packet**

March 11th, 2022

Welcome 5th Grade Parents, Guardians and Families,

Your MPH family is eager to meet your incoming 6th-grade student in August 2022. To assist your student with the transition to middle school, please see below and reference our MPH website for more information about our school.

The first question your student may be wondering is what is a day in the life of a 6th-grade middle school student like at MPH? This upcoming year will be our fifth year of the middle school model, where all students are placed in one of three 6<sup>th</sup> grade teams. Each team is composed of core teachers who provide your student with instruction in English, Math, Social Studies, Science, and an elective. Your student will also have a P.E. teacher and P.E. class daily. Your student will transition to all six periods utilizing a passing period in our upper A building that is devoted to our 6th-grade students and will have lunch during C lunch.

Your student will engage in an incoming 6th-grade presentation via their 5th-grade visits to MPH between March 21<sup>st,</sup> 2022– March 25<sup>th,</sup> 2022, with our school counselors Mrs. Wharrie and Mrs. Neal. The 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Elective Form, General Application (if the application-based class is desired), Honors, and any other positive requests must be received by **April 29<sup>th</sup>**, **2022.** Please remember forms not submitted by April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022 will not be considered. Additionally, preferences are not a guarantee, however, we do make every effort to accommodate. Honors placement is based on the MPH criteria (see document) for the 33 slots available for 6<sup>th</sup>-grade Honors ELA and Math. After the criteria are considered, a parent/guardian may request placement on the Honors waiting list.

At MPH we have high expectations for our students as they work towards high school, college, career, and beyond. As such we teach and model expectations of respect, responsibility, and safety to all our students following our award-winning PBIS model. Students who are "caught" doing the right thing can earn Mountain "Lion Loot" to be redeemed for exciting opportunities and incentives like having the Principal run your mile. Additionally, your PBIS team hosts expectations assemblies and sponsors celebratory events.

Your MPH family would like to invite our families to engage in your student's education and our school by considering participation in School Site Council, PTA, ELAC, PBIS team, and/or other volunteer opportunities. 
- \*Criterion listed above are minimums, however, placement may require higher achievement levels based on availability in each class.
