## D. SUPERINTENDENT'S COMMENTS

Dr. Carmen Day began her comments by sharing that Officer Teague, the District's SRO was being promoted to a detective, and that she was grateful that the Upland Police Department had ensured that the District would be covered until the right person is chosen to serve Upland students. Dr. Carmen Day shared that the UCollege classroom ribbon cutting would be held on August 18th at 11:45 a.m., and she invited community members to attend. Superintendent Carmen Day described her excitement as preparation for the start of school, August 22nd was underway, and how pleased she was to hear about the different events taking place to help students feel more connected to their schools in advance. She shared that a number of professional development activities took place during the summer, including Footsteps to Freedom, the National Climate and Culture Conference, County Wellness Conference, and the Ron Clark Academy. Also shared was that preliminary results had come in for English Langauge Arts and Math, with more formal results to come in the fall. In closing, Dr. Carmen Day shared that National Night Out would be taking place on August 2nd at Cabrillo Park where students and families could take part in science experiments, community building, and even a visit from the Upland Police Department. All were welcome to attend.

#### E. BOARD COMMENTS AND FUTURE TOPICS

Trustee Fifield greeted all who were in attendance and expressed his hopes that all had a great summer break.

Trustee Young shared that he would be hosting an event at his home for National Night Out, as he has done in the past. He shared that he attended the Baldy View ROP meeting and that they started their in-service training 7/26/22. In closing, Mr. Young inquired about the readiness of Pioneer's driveway for the start of school.

Vice-President Bennett expressed his excitement and appreciation for being one of the few that had the opportunity to attend Footsteps to Freedom. He shared that it was a great and moving experience. Mr. Bennett described some of the trip to the audience and shared how he stood on the grounds where slave auctions had once occured, climbed a hill where the Ohio River once crossed, and where the slaves would have seen the light from the hill which was a station for the Underground Railroad. Mr. Bennett also shared the sad news of Roger Schulte's passing on July 18, 2022, and that he was a former Pioneer Junior High Principal, and Upland Rotary Member. Trustee Bennett shared that this was a giant loss to the community, and asked all to keep his family and wife in their prayers. In closing, Mr. Bennett inquired about the repair of 6 Solar Electric panels and that he would like to ensure it continued to move forward.

Trustee Garnett greeted all who were in attendance and spoke about his participation at the annual 4th of July celebration along with Mr. Young & Mr. Bennett. Mr. Garnett made a recommendation to the Superintendent to have a booth next year. Trustee Garnett shared that he was not present at the last board meeting out of caution due to COVID exposure. In closing, Mr. Garnett provided information about independent study regulations and his desire to ensure parents who have students on independent study know that there has been another significant update.
