What is the CAASPP?

* CAASPP stands for the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress.

* CAASPP is the new state test that students in 3rd-6th grade took last spring.





Who took the CAASPP?

- * The CAASPP assessments:
 - SBAC Assessments-3rd-6th graders
 - * English Language Arts
 - * Math
 - CST/CMA/CAPA Test- 5th graders
 - * Science
 - CA Alternate Test identified 3rd-6th grade special education students





Facts about the SBAC

* SBAC:

- online assessment
- measures student's mastery of grade level CA standards in ELA and math
- two components:
 - * computer adaptive
 - * performance task
- students must show how they came to their answer





Will parents receive scores?

* In the past students in CA took the CST assessment. Parents received their child's results in the mail after school started.

* Parents will receive their child's SBAC scores in the mail by fall break.





Components of student score report

* SBAC:

- student score report looks different:
 - * scale score
 - * achievement level
 - * claim information
- cannot compare SBAC scores with previous CST scores
- baseline information this year





Scale Scores

- Range is from 2,000 to 3,000
- Dot shows student's scale score (2508)
- Bar shows where the student's scores may fall if student takes the same test again
- This is the score to look for next year to show student's growth.










The CAASPP English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics tests that Juan took in the spring more broadly refu_.(California's stateadopted content standards than California's old tests, with content that will be needed to prepare students for college and the 21st century job market. These new tests contain a wider variety of questions than traditional multiple-choice tests and include tasks and test items that require students to explain how they solve problems.
