

6th GRADE CAMP PACKING LIST

**LABEL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME!*

◆ Bedding:

- Sleeping Bag or blankets and sheets
- Pillow

◆ Bathroom Essentials:

- Bath towel (large)
- Shampoo (2 in 1 is best)
- Toothbrush
- Sunscreen (even if it's cold, the sun may still be shining)
- (optional) Plastic sandals/flip-flops to wear in shower **ONLY**
- (optional) Chapstick- especially with the cold weather
- (optional) Lotion (not a sweet smelling kind)
- (optional) Deodorant
- (optional) Bug Spray
- **NO** makeup, hairspray, gel, smelly lotions, etc. (this will attract insects)
- **NO** hairdryers, curling irons, jewelry (no watches, earrings, necklaces, etc.)
- Toothpaste
- Soap (body wash is better than bar soap)
- Hair brush

◆ Clothing:

- Heavy jacket (if cold)
- Sweatshirt
- Shoes (2 comfortable pairs-just in case one gets wet)
- Long pants (2-4)
- Short-sleeved and long-sleeved T-shirts (4)
- Under garments (4-5)
- Socks (6-8 pairs- they will get sweaty on hikes and you may want to change them)
- Hat (to keep off the sun) and/or Beanie (for when it is cold)
- Pajamas
- (optional) gloves and/or raincoat
- **NO** opened toed shoes to wear outside (okay for the shower)
- **NO** spaghetti strapped tank tops or midriiffs

◆ Equipment and extras:

- Water bottle
- (optional) Stationary-Paper, envelopes, address and stamps
- 1-3 independent reading books
- Extra plastic bag for dirty clothes
- **NO** electronics of any kind (no cell phones, games, iPods, etc.) **CAMERAS are ok!**
- **NO** money, candy, gum, or food of any kind
- **NO** flashlights, matches, knives, hatchets, etc.
