Can You Spot The Fake?

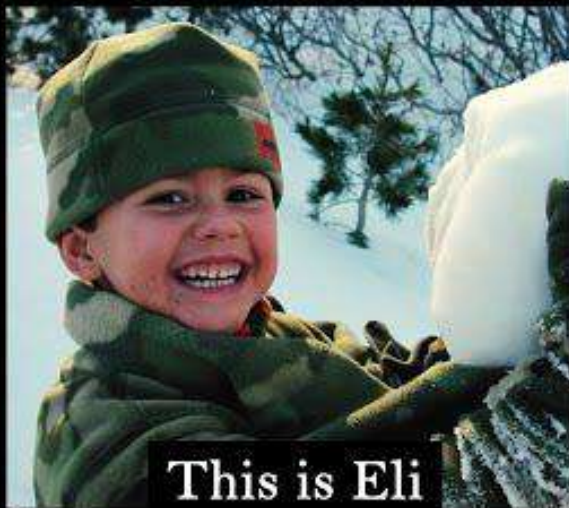
A fake can look exactly like a prescription pill



Each fake pill might have up to 5 different chemicals—including fentanyl—which can cause overdose and death.



ELI'S STORY:



Last year, Eli was a 17 year-old student at Centennial High School; independent and smart.

Unbeknown to his parents, Eli began ordering pills online to cope with a medical condition. The night Eli died, he took a fake Xanax. His father found him at 2am, slumped over his computer. Attempts to resuscitate Eli failed; he was pronounced dead.

Eli passed away at home his senior year of high school, just months prior to what would have been his High School graduation - Centennial High School, class of 2021.

SIGNS OF AN OVERDOSE:



Won't wake up



Slow or no breathing



Cold & clammy skin



Blue lips or nails



Tiny pupils







Gurgling or snoring

WHAT TO DO IF YOU THINKS SOMEONE HAS OVERDOSED:

- ★ IF YOU ARE AROUND SOMEONE WHO IS DRINKING OR DOING DRUGS, AND THEY PASS OUT (ARE NON-RESPONSIVE) CALL 911. NEVER LEAVE AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON ALONE. NOT EVEN TO “SLEEP IT OFF.”
- ★ THE GOOD SAMARITAN LAW PROTECTS YOU IF/WHEN YOU CALL 911: PROTECTION FROM ARREST, CHARGES AND PROSECUTION FOR PEOPLE WHO SEEK EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE AT THE SCENE OF A SUSPECTED OVERDOSE.

TAKE THE PLEDGE:

I PLEDGE TO...

-  Never take a random pill - I will only take pills prescribed to me by my own doctor.
-  Spread the word - I will tell my friends who may be experimenting, recreationally using, or struggling with substances about the dangers of fake pills.
-  Find alternatives - I will explore healthier ways to cope with my pain, stress or anxiety.
-  Be available - I will be honest with myself and supportive of others when speaking of mental health and substance use.
