Course description: Sixth grade honors math is designed to help students prepare for Algebra 1. Students taking this course should have basic arithmetic skills, but may need some review. Please remember that this is an honors class and it will take some work and studying to grasp the concepts.

Topics Covered:

Fractions, Decimals, and Percents
Ratios and Proportional Relationships
Expressions and Equations
Integers
Geometry
Statistics and Probability

Absent Work: Students have one week from the date of absence to make up any missing work. The grade will be entered as a zero until the work is made up.

Late Work: No late work is accepted. I do give 3 late work passes per semester for those days when something inhibits the completion of homework.

Assignments:

Homework is due the following class period, unless stated otherwise

I suggest that the homework is done the day I give it, so it is still fresh in your memory and you can get help the next day if you need it.

Students need to show their work on all assignments to receive full credit.

Grading: Grades are weighted:	Homework	10%
	Work (classwork/Notebook)	30%
	Assessments	60%

Grading: Grades are weighted, which means that tests are worth 60% and assignments are worth 40%.
