#### About 5th Grade

- Snack time will be each morning after Specials.

# Classroom Expectations

- School is a place to learn. As such, your child needs to approach school with a positive attitude each day ready to put forth their best effort.
- School is a place where your child should feel safe. Any student that isn't safe will need to go to a SAFE SEAT where they can get themselves ready for learning. If they can't, they will be escorted to a buddy room or the principal's office.

# Communication and Reinforcement

- Our classroom is like a community where students work for the betterment of the group.
- 1. School rules and expectations are clearly emphasized and discussed.
- 2. Classroom goals are set by all students.
- 3. Reinforcement is in place to encourage a positive learning environment.
- 4. Open lines of communication between staff, parents, and teachers is imperative.
  - 1. Weekly newsletters will be **EMAILED** home at the end of every week. Please check your email on a regular basis & make sure it doesn't accidently end up in your "junk" folder. Please provide us with your email so, we may get these & other important announcements to you.

### Grading

- Classwork will be 20% of their overall grade.
- •Summative assessments will include quizzes, tests, & projects. Summative assessments will be 80% of their overall grade.
- •We will keep track of homework completion & it will be recorded in the gradebook.
- •Corrections can be completed on quizzes & tests(except for spelling tests) when students receive lower than 70%. Students who have achieved mastery(70% or higher), will not be completing corrections. Students who make corrections can only make corrections once, they must be turned in by the indicated due date, & they will receive a score no higher than 70% for their final score. The lowest quiz/test score will be dropped from each subject once there is more than 1 quiz/test score in the gradebook.

#### Homework Policies

- I believe that students are at school to learn. If students complete their work at school they will have little homework. At the beginning of each week your child will bring home their spelling words for the week. The spelling test will be held at the end of each week.
- Students will also have 10 spiral review math problems to complete each evening. Always check with your student daily for homework (this will mainly be studying spelling words, reading, and reviewing math concepts.)
- Each evening your child will be bringing home a student planner that outlines their homework. This will need to be checked by parents nightly.
- If your child misses school, he/she will need to ask for the work they missed and then complete it and return it. For example: for each day your child misses, they have that many days to make up the missed work.

#### 100% Club

- Students who complete all of their homework on time for two consecutive weeks
- AND do not receive a minor or major for two consecutive weeks, will receive a reward for their hard work & dedication! ©

#### Illnesses and Medication

- If your child is sick, please call the office at 632-3400 before 9:00 a.m.
- If you would like for me to send homework with a sibling or you will pick up the work, please call in advance so I can have time to prepare the work.
- If you send any medication to school with your child, including cough drops, please make sure you send a note with instructions so this information can be passed on to the nurse along with all medications.

#### Attendance

- For your student to have the best experience possible, it is important that they attend school on a regular basis.
- Students should be on time to school each day and prepared for class. It is best if they remain at school for the entire school day unless there is an emergency.

#### Dismissal

- If you have a change in how your child is getting home, please contact the office at 632-3400 before 2:00 p.m
- Car riders will need to display their car rider card each day. Make sure you have it readily visible.
