A successful, traditional event at Morrill is WEB Day. This innovative 6th grade student orientation event (and new incoming 7th/8th graders), titled Where Everybody Belongs (WEB), is an internationally recognized program where eighth and seventh graders serve as leaders and mentors to our new 6th grade students. The fun and action packed orientation is scheduled for <u>Thursday</u>, <u>August 15th</u>, starting at 7:00 AM in the BYC. On WEB day, incoming 6th graders and other 7th/8th grade students new to Morrill will participate in a variety of fun and exciting group activities designed to facilitate the transition from elementary school to middle school.

WEB leaders will be selected because of their personal and social traits exhibited during the year, along with strong teacher recommendations. On August 6th, 7th and 8th, our WEB leaders will attend three half days of focused training. They must be present <u>ALL three</u> days, come on time and stay for the complete training sessions and/or <u>WEB</u> event or they will be dropped from the program. In addition to hosting the orientation, the WEB leaders will stay in contact with their group and lead the 6th graders in a number of other activities during the year. Other events they are <u>expected</u> to participate in and help out at are: Back to School Night (September), WEB Leader Social (September/October), Career Day (March/April) and WEB Invitationals (May). Other events that WEB Leaders can come help out at are: 6th grade movie nights, dances and graduation. Students are also expected to complete 16 hours of community service for a non-family member and not get paid for their services or volunteer for the after school homework club twice per month on Tuesdays. Due dates will be given throughout the school year.
