Health Office

Parents can find medication forms for the 2022-2023 school year on our CVUSD website. To locate medical forms please go to Departments, you will see Health Services on a drop-down menu. Click there then look for Health Services Forms. Click on Health Services Forms and you will find forms for specific health concerns. Please complete all forms under the condition that applies to your student. These forms are for students that require medication during school hours.

As a reminder, if your student has a fever, they need to be fever 24 hours without any medication, prior to returning to school.

Now is the time to make sure your student is up to date on the required immunizations for 7th grade. Please provide a copy of a current immunization record to the health office. This will avoid delays when registering for Junior high school.

- Students entering 7th grade need to show proof of a Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) and Varicella 1 and 2 booster shot before starting school.
- 7th Grade students will not be able to attend school or receive a class schedule without showing proof of the Tdap/Pertussis booster vaccine and Varicella 1 and 2.

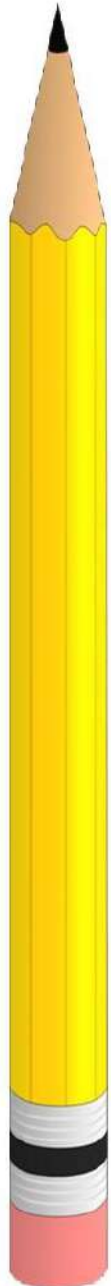

Dear 6th Graders,

We have now opened up Round Two of Leadership applications for Incoming 7th Graders (Current 6th grade students) to Townsend Junior High School on the Townsend web site. Current 6th graders with excellent academics and work habits, exemplary citizenship and who will attend Townsend Junior High school in the 2022–23 school year are invited to submit applications online at <https://forms.gle/mGzfkSM89Uquwvs8> for the Leadership class by May 9, 2022. Student applicants are also responsible for sending this link: <https://forms.gle/Qe9m4HMm7pyfcgRg9> to their current teachers as well as an influential adult (who is not a relative) so that they may complete the recommendation by the application due date.

Students who apply to the Leadership class are evaluated on the basis of their application answers, grades, citizenship, and teacher / adult recommendation forms. The student's name and school is not considered during the selection process. Approximately 30 incoming 7th grade students are selected to fill the class, based on contract–negotiated class size. A waiting list is established for the remaining eligible students. Students will be added to the class if openings in their grade level become available, according to the numerical order of the waiting list. The Leadership class list for incoming 7th graders will be posted online at the Townsend website with first name and last initial only along with the last 5 digits of the student's CVUSD student ID number on May 27, 2022. Last name should be verified by the office. The waiting list is kept by the scheduling secretary.
