- Assignments listed in Google Classroom

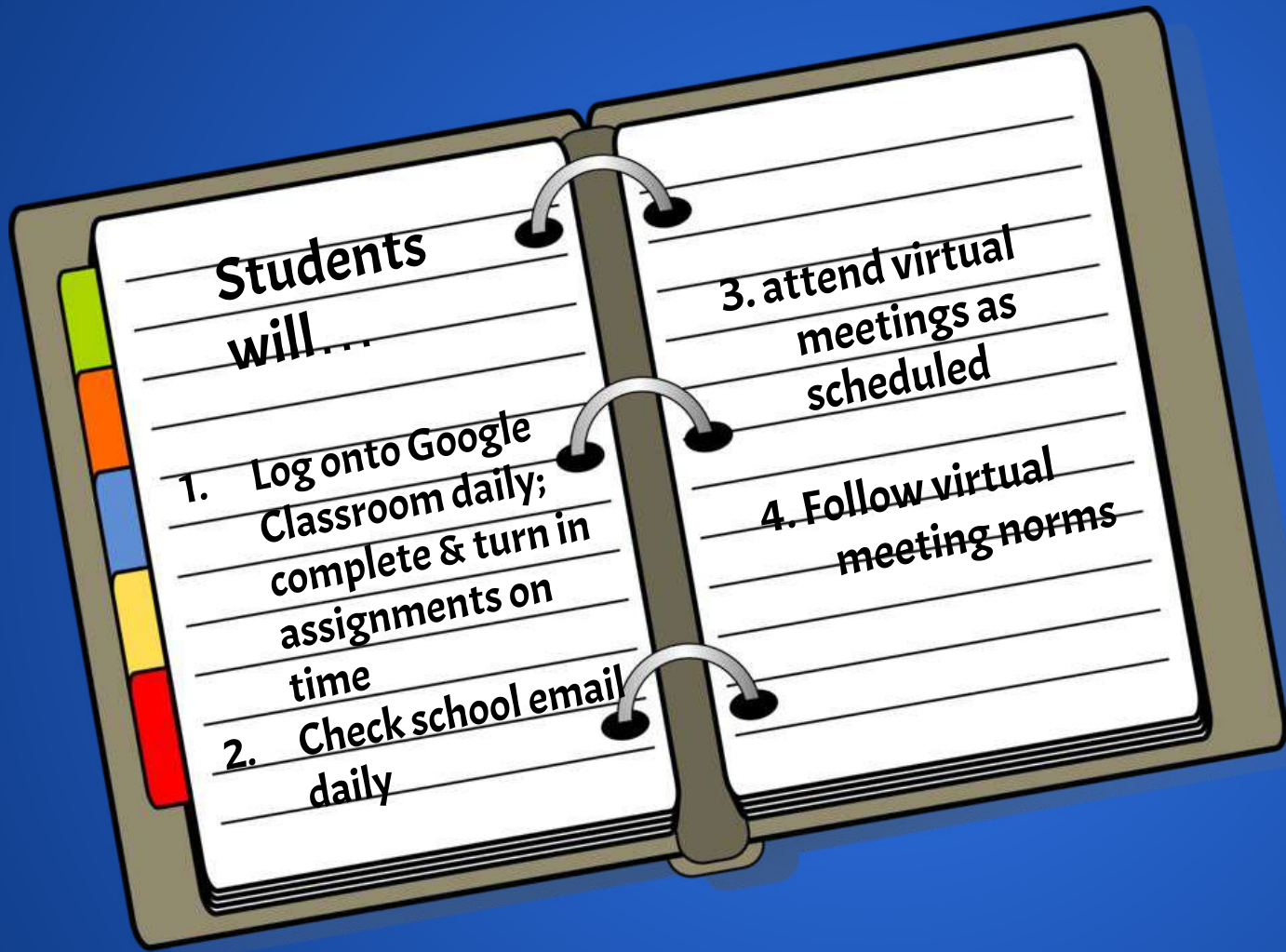
ATTENDANCE POLICY

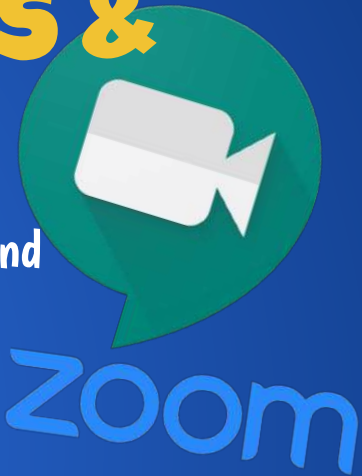

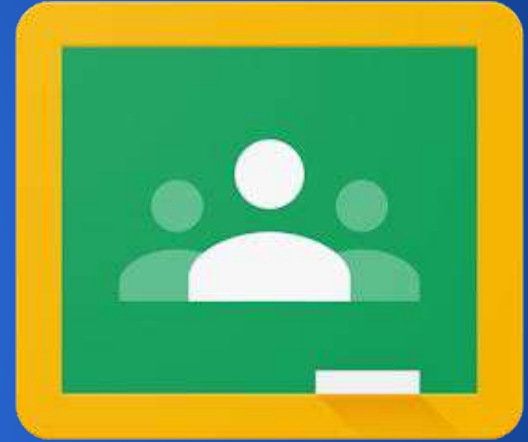

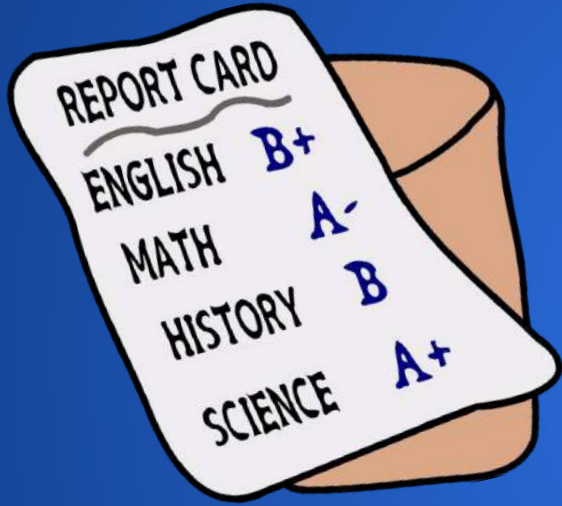


ASSIGNMENT INFORMATION
