The AVID Elective is a 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade component of the AVID Secondary System that prepares students in the academic middle for admission to a four-year college or university. Students take the AVID Elective course throughout junior high and high school, which provides them with the skills needed to be successful in advancing academically with the ultimate goal of attending college. For more than 30 years, AVID has been instrumental in preparing students for success in higher education.

The core component of the AVID Secondary System is the AVID Elective, which supports students as they challenge themselves in more rigorous classes. Students are taught study skills, note-taking, time management, writing skills, and research skills, while being immersed in a college-going culture. The class also includes tutoring sessions that are led by college students and provides support for success in the academically rigorous curriculum.
