



Exploratory Wheel: See below for a sample of the Wheel courses.

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
AVID- In Exploratory AVID, students will learn study and organizational skills as well as gain knowledge about college/universities and potential careers.



Art -In Exploratory Art, students will explore the basic elements of art and principles of design as established in the state art standards.



Coding - Students will use the C programming language to code while exploring the interactive world of Arduino.Will work on a series of self-paced lessons and design challenges.



Music - In Exploratory Music, students will explore the elements of music including the reading of music, sound generation, modification and structure. Students are exposed to classical and contemporary musical forms



Medical Detectives - Students play the role of real-life medical detectives as they analyze genetic testing results, solve medical mysteries, measure and interpret vital signs, and learn how the systems of the human body work together to maintain health.



Speech + Debate - In Exploratory Speech/Debate, students will explore various oral communication skills to increase personal confidence when speaking before a group.

Competition Robotics

*An application is required - Applications are due by **Wednesday, April 27**

Competition Robotics is a class dedicated to building, programming, and competing with a VEX robot. You will increase your skills in communication, teamwork, and engineering. You do not need prior robotics experience to be considered a great fit for the team.

There are 2 class periods for competition robotics:

VEX IQ: 6th and 7th Grade *Incoming 6th is only eligible for the VEX IQ team. VEX VRC: 7th and 8th Grade

*Competition robotics **will NOT** be an option to select in Aeries. Please select other available electives in Aeries. If you are selected for the team, you will be placed in the course.

Step #2:


- With your parent, select your (first choice) ONE elective this will be your PRIMARY elective. Also, select TWO ALTERNATE electives - these will be "back up" electives.







Choosing Electives - Alternate Requests





Step #3:

The window to select courses is Saturday, April 16th - Sunday, May 1st. Complete your elective selection in Aeries by <u>May 1</u>.

Please Note:

If you have not selected your 1 Primary and 2 Alternate electives by Sunday, May 1 in Aeries, you will be placed into electives by Counselors/Administration.

Final Reminders:

- You have selected 3 electives in your Aeries portal (ONE Primary Request and TWO Alternate Request)
- <u>Choose electives carefully and thoughtfully</u>. You may not be given an opportunity to make changes throughout the year.
- Every effort will be made to schedule you into your chosen electives. However, we cannot guarantee placement in any elective course. Your second choice will be used if we are unable to place you in the first elective that you have chosen.
- Student musicians may require a schedule adjustment during the first few weeks of school, as appropriate placement is determined by the music teacher .
- Deadline to select your 3 electives (1 Primary & 2 Alternates) is May 1.
- We reserve the right to change elective selections depending on data, school staffing, course requests and other miscellaneous factors.
