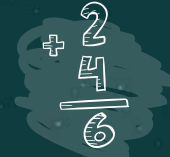
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## REGULAR GRADE VS. IB GRADES



### REGULAR

Regular grades are letter grades. These grades range from the letters A through F. A being the highest grade you can receive and F being the lowest grade you can receive. Each letter grades comes with its assigned percentage. This percentage can change depending on each of the teachers.



### IB

IB grades are exclusive to the IB 7th and 8th graders. Unlike regular grades, they are scored through numbers and criterions. These numbers range from 0 through 8. 0 being the lowest scores you can receives and 8 being the highest score. You will receive these scores based on work that is done for each assigned class. There will be 4 different scores because there are 4 different criterions.
