REGULAR

Regular grades are letter grades. These grades range from the letters A through F. A being the highest grade you can receive and F being the lowest grade you can receive. Each letter grades comes with its assigned percentage. This percentage can change depending on each of the teachers.



IB

IB grades are exclusive to the IB 7th and 8th graders. Unlike regular grades, they are scored through numbers and criterions. Theses numbers numbers range from 0 through 8. 0 being the lowest scores you can receives and 8 being the highest score.
