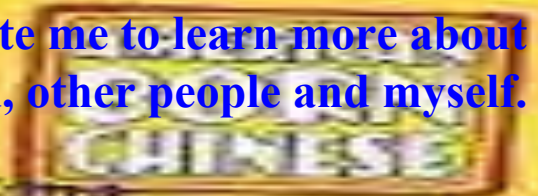
Graphic novels are NOT comic books!

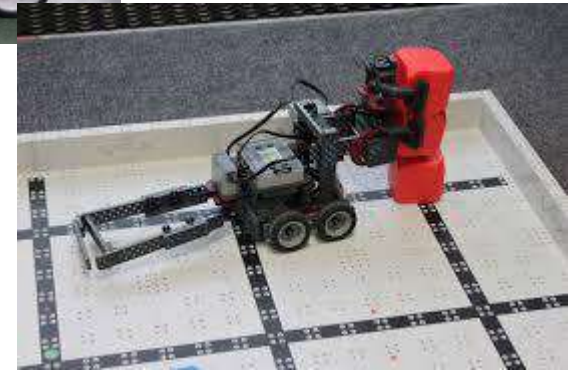

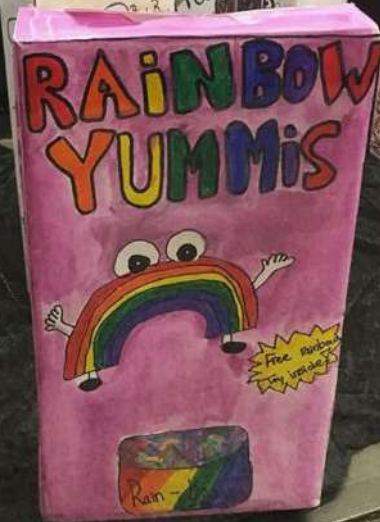
