What is WEB?

W.E.B., Where Everybody Belongs, is a middle school orientation and transition to middle school program. We welcome and embrace students from diverse backgrounds and who have unique talents, interests, and characteristics. At Ramirez, WEB is a <u>year-long</u> program (and 5th period class) where 8th grade leaders conduct activities to prepare incoming 7th graders for middle school. Activities include: A high energy, inspirational Orientation and Assembly, monthly group activities, peer mentoring, tutoring, and structured gatherings.

The Main Components of WEB:

- 7th Grade Transition: Through this nationally recognized middle school transition program, select 8th grade students are trained to act as positive role models, mentors, and teachers who guide the 7th graders to discover what it takes to be successful in middle school.
- 8th Grade WEB Leadership Development: WEB promotes leadership and service in our 8th grade WEB Leaders. It provides training in leadership development and organizes intentional opportunities to serve and lead incoming 7th grade students.
- Creating a Welcoming Environment: The WEB middle school transition program helps to enhance anti-bullying efforts, reduce discipline issues, and increase school safety, creating an improved school climate and a greater sense of connection for the whole school.
