Instructions for 7th Grade 2021-2022 Registration Card

<u>ACADEMIC COURSES</u>: Every student will be assigned four academic classes. The classes are Language Arts, Science, World Geography, and Math. Students will be placed in the appropriate Math class according to the district criteria.

REQUIRED WELLNESS COURSES: PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH

These courses are required for all seventh grade students and will not be waived to take additional 20 week elective courses. In the case a 7th grader wishes to take *two full year elective courses- a full year of Music along with a Level 1 World Language-* the Physical Education and Health requirement will be waived.

<u>WORLD LANGUAGE</u> –Students have the opportunity to begin learning a Level 1 World Language in 7th grade; however, it is not a required elective in 7th grade. Students successfully completing the Level 1 language course in 7th grade can then take Level 2 of that language in 8th grade or in high school. Students receive a high school credit for passing this course. For this reason, they should be organized students who are capable of handling a high school level work load. The grade they receive in this course will be on the high school transcript that goes to colleges. It will not, however, be factored into the high school grade point average (GPA). Please be aware that once enrolled in 7th grade language, it is not an option to drop the language class during that school year and switch to another elective.

ELECTIVE COURSES – Students will take 1 full-year elective **OR** 2 semester electives.

- If your choice is 1 full year elective, please rank the order of the choice of your World Language elective (1-4) or mark an "X" next to the choice for a music course choice.
- If your choice is 2 semester electives, the 20-week elective classes must be ranked in order of preference (1-6). Every effort will be made to give students their top choices.

*Band 7 or Orchestra 7 should only be selected if it was taken in 6th grade or special arrangements have been made through the Band teacher.

- 1. Discuss with and assist your child in making the appropriate elective class selections.
- 2. Fill out the registration card completely.
- 3. Include your signature at the bottom of the registration card.

- 1. Sign the bottom of the registration card.
