Amplify ELA is also offering downloadable student components for temporary use at the following website:

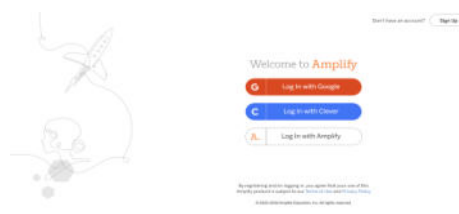
