Hello 8th Grade Families.

We are happy to announce that we will be holding an 8th Grade Promotion to celebrate students promoting to high school. To be eligible for the End of Year Activities, including the Promotion, students must meet the following criteria (per Board Policy):

REQUIREMENTS

- Maintaining a 2.0 GPA with no more than two (2) "unsatisfactory" (U) citizenship grades.
- Complying with school rules including not violating any portion of Education Code 48900.
- ➤ No excessive discipline problems. Frequent discipline infractions may result in disqualification from 8th grade related activities. Site administration will determine eligibility for the 8th Grade Send-off or related activities considering any disciplinary consequences.

TIMELINE OF EVENTS

Friday, May 14, 2021 at 3:30 P.M.: Grade point average (GPA), citizenship marks, owed fees, and discipline incidents will be reviewed to determine eligibility for <u>all</u> End of the Year Activities.

Friday, May 21, 2021: Return all material (textbooks, chrome books, hotspots, instruments, etc.) during your History Period.

Monday, May 24, 2021: Settle all lost and/or damaged books and technology as well as outstanding fines/charges owed.

Friday, May 28, 2021: DISTANCE LEARNING STUDENTS- Return all material (textbooks, chrome books, hotspots, instruments, etc.) to the library 12:30- 2:30

May 17-24: End of Year Activities TBD **May 25 and 26:** Promotion Practice

Students not eligible to participate in End of the Year Activities will participate in an alternative activity supervised by a teacher.

PROMOTION INFORMATION

For Promotion, we will adhere to limitations based on the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines:

- This will be a <u>pre-registration ONLY event</u>. Each participating student will receive two (2) tickets for family members who reside in the same household. You will be sent a Google Form link to your email to pre-register for your assigned seating (2 guests of the same household and seating location will be on a lottery basis) on the week of May 10.
- Attendees are to self-screen for fever or any other COVID related symptoms before leaving their home for the Send-off Ceremony. Please note that if any participate is feeling ill, have symptoms of COVID-19, or have potentially been exposed to someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19, they should not attend the Promotion event.
