PROMOTION INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Dear 8th Grade Parent:

We are looking ahead to the end of the school year, which is an important time for our 8th grade students.

Promotion will take place Thursday, May 26th at 8:30 am in the Cal Aero Preserve Academy Gymnasium.

Due to our expanding 8th grade class size, in order to comply with the max occupancy set by fire code for the gym, each student who meets the eligibility requirements listed below will receive 4 tickets to the promotion ceremony for family members/guests.

- In order for a student to participate in the Cal Aero promotion ceremony, he/she must have met the requirements established by the Chino Valley Unified School District Board of Education's Promotion and Retention Recommendation Policy. Students must have a 2.0 GPA in their final trimester and no more than (two) 2 "unsatisfactory" (U) citizenship grades.
- Students must pay any fees for lost or damaged textbooks or Chromebook to participate in the promotion ceremony

Tickets will be sent home with your student on Tuesday, May 24th once eligibility is confirmed. **Tickets must be presented to enter the gym for promotion**. The front doors to the community center/gym will open at 8:00 am for parents/guests. Promoting 8th graders need to report to the lunch tables no later than 8:00 am appropriately dressed and ready for promotion. The ceremony will start promptly at 8:30 am.

Dress Code for Promotion:

For the Promotion Ceremony:

Boys are encouraged to wear nice pants and shoes, with collared shirts (ties and/or vests are okay).

Girls are encouraged to wear nice pants with a blouse, skirt, or dress. Dress shoulder straps must be no less than 2 adult fingers wide. Dress length is to be as follows, falling as long as the longest finger when arms are rested comfortably to the side. Sandals must have a heel strap. No formals please.

Due to the parking lot space, limousines/party buses are not permitted.

Students in violation of the dress code will be required to change clothes and/or shoes to participate in the Promotion Ceremony.
