#### **REQUIREMENTS FOR PROMOTION**

#### DRESS GUIDELINE FOR PROMOTION CEREMONY

We want to ensure that our students dress comfortably for the ceremony. Students will not be wearing gowns. Clothing must still conform to the TUSD dress code. Gross negligence of this policy may result in exclusion from the ceremony.

	GIRLS:	
Appropriate:	Skirts or dresses, Sundresses, Capris, etc.	
Inappropriate:	Short shorts, spaghetti-strap tops, revealing tops or bottoms, formal dresses, etc.	
BOYS:		
Appropriate:	Polo shirts, Shirts and ties, slacks or khakis, etc.	
Inappropriate:	Baggy shorts, tank tops, cut-off sleeved shirts, tuxedos or suits, etc.	

<u>Balloons, noise makers and other distractions will not be allowed</u> during the promotion ceremony nor will students be allowed to carry any flowers, balloons or gifts during the ceremony.

#### **PROMOTION CERMONY TICKETS**

Each student will be provided 4 tickets. Student will sign for their tickets, verifying they did receive them, following their Promotion Practice. If your child loses or misplaces their tickets, they will not be reissued additional tickets.
