Important Notes:

1. If you signed up for leadership in the Spring and were approved by Mrs. Hohnstein, you will be in Leadership and do not have to complete this form. If you don't remember whether you signed up for leadership, check with the office we have a list.
2. All 8th grade students will take one quarter of 8th Grade Success.
3. While we will do our best to give you your choices, we can't guarantee that we will be able to do that due to limited space in some classes.
4. 7th and 8th grade students who fail two or more classes may be required to have a mandatory Study Hall instead of an exploratory class.
5. Exploratory classes are thirty minutes long and take place four days a week. They are Pass/No Pass only. Exploratory classes change every 9 weeks at the beginning of a new quarter.
6. Students cannot request a class change for an exploratory class.
