The attached permission form and \$55.00 must be returned as soon as possible.

(Return no later than Friday, June 1st) We need to order tickets on that date, so the permission slip must be returned by then to guarantee your student's spot on the trip. There will be **no refunds** because we will be purchasing tickets in advance of the trip. Students should bring money on the day of the trip for lunch, dinner and souvenirs at Six Flags, as those are NOT included in the price.

- ALL TEXTBOOKS, LIBRARY BOOKS, CHROMEBOOKS, UNIFORMS, LOCKS, ETC. MUST BE TURNED IN AND ALL FINES, OR DEBTS PAID

While on a field trip, students are representing our school district and all school rules apply. Student's responsible behavior is required in order to participate in extra-curricular activities. Parents are responsible for picking up their child at Marine World in Vallejo should a problem occur during the field trip. Any student, who is late returning to the bus, resulting in additional cost for buses, may be responsible for paying the extra charges.

In the event of illness or injury, I do hereby consent to whatever x-ray, examination, anesthetic, medical, surgical or dental diagnosis or treatment and hospital care considered necessary in the best judgment of the attending physician, surgeon, or dentist and performed under the supervision of a member of the medical staff of the hospital or facility furnishing medical or dental services.

Please be aware that California Education Code 35330 provides in part that:

All persons making the field trip or excursion shall be deemed to have waived all claims against the district, a charter school, or the State of California for injury, accident, illness, or death occurring during or by reason of the field trip or excursion.

I fully understand that participants are to abide by all rules and regulations governing conduct during this trip. Any violation of these rules and regulations may result in that individual being sent home at the expense of his/her parent/guardian.

I am fully aware that the field trip that I am choosing to allow my child to participate in may be physically or emotionally demanding. I affirm that my child's health is good and that he/she is not under a physician's care for any undisclosed condition that bears upon his/her fitness to participate in the activity as noted above. I voluntarily elect to allow my child to participate in the program and to assume the risk of injury or harm that could result from participation. I release Grass Valley School District, Lyman Gilmore Middle School, its staff members and volunteers from all liability for injury harm or damage from participating in the above mentioned activities whether the injury or harm is caused by the negligence of the Grass Valley School District, Lyman Gilmore Middle School, its staff members or volunteers or otherwise. This release is binding upon my heirs, executors and assigns. I have read and understand this release of liability. I have voluntarily signed on the reverse side of this form.

Lyman Gilmore 8th Grade GRADUATION INFORMATION

Basic Information:

- Graduation for Lyman Gilmore 8th-grade students will be Wednesday, June 13, 2018
- Graduates should be on the blacktop area at 6:30 PM with their graduation robe
- Ceremonies will begin promptly at 7:00 PM and conclude about 8:00 PM
- Seating is on a first come basis and seats cannot be "saved" in advance (Exception - section may be reserved for volunteers, and staff)
- You may want to bring a folding chair of your own; we have approximately 1000 seats. NO tickets necessary
- Parking available at Nevada Irrigation District and Peace Lutheran parking lots across the street (NID lot closes promptly at 9pm)
- Robe turn-in at the Gilmore library doors right after ceremony
- Grad dance/party begins in the multipurpose room after ceremony (and robe turn-in :)

Graduation Dress Code Requirements

This is a very special event for both families and students. We suggest, students' attire be somewhat dressier than regular school clothes.

Graduates will be wearing graduation robes over their clothes for the ceremony. Robes will be checked out to students during school on

Tuesday. (Students will be measured for robe sizes in PE)

Boys: Shirt with a collar, slacks or khaki pants, and ties.

We have extra ties to loan, which will be available on the blacktop just before graduation. Vests, sweaters, or jackets are optional. **Jeans, T-shirts, and hats are NOT allowed.**

Girls: Dresses should be special but **not formal**. Dress length is to be no longer than mid-calf or no shorter than just above the knee. Spaghetti straps and high back halter dresses are permitted. *Strapless, low back, lace-up back, or bare midriff styles are NOT allowed.* Dressy pants are appropriate. **Long formal dresses will NOT be permitted for any reason.** **If you are unsure that your outfit is OK, you may bring it by and ask the secretaries or an administrator.**

******Graduates with inappropriate attire may not be allowed to attend the grad party******

Grad/Dance Party will be in the MPR for Gilmore graduates **ONLY**. Party will follow the ceremony, and continue until 10:30 PM. Only LGMS graduates will be admitted to the party. There will be a dance, photo room, and game area.

Reminder: We will have an early release schedule on Tuesday, and Wednesday, June 12, and 13. with dismissal at 1:50.
