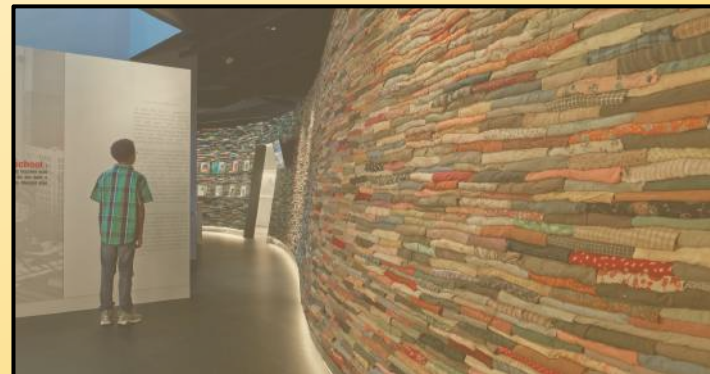
8TH Grade Activities

Promotion Ceremony Attire

Promotion Requirements

- Any student who does not meet the promotion criteria will **NOT** be allowed to participate in **ANY** of the eighth grade activities and be placed on Board of Review.
